You may be eligible for financial assistance.

The Pre-Apprenticeship Training Program is an initiative developed and administered by the Province of Ontario, Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

Through the Skills Development program, Human Resources and Skills Development Canada can provide financial assistance for unemployed, Employment Insurance (EI)-eligible individuals who lack marketable skills and require training in order to find employment.
